



WIEP continues to be one of the few exhibitions that still accepts large prints. This year we received over 1400 prints and over 1600 projected images from around the world. We were both pleased and grateful that many of our entrants selected the donation option during entry to help support our efforts. GARY POTTS, APSA, GMPSA, EFIAP, FISHERS, IN Gary currently serves as the Executive Vice President of the Photographic Society of America (PSA). In recognition of success in exhibitions, he achieved his GMPSA distinction in 2015 as well as his EFIAP from the International Federation of Photographic Art. At the 2017 PSA Conference in Pittsburgh, he was awarded the honor of Associate (APSA) for his service to the society. Gary enjoys all types of photography and subject matter, but in recent years he has focused much of his interest on studio portraiture. He also enjoys participating in a PSA Digital Study Group on

infrared photography. He presented programs at the 2015, 2016 and 2017 Conferences on the subjects of infrared photography and winning with prints. Gary and his wife of 48 years, Sarah, reside in Fishers, Indiana and have three adult sons and nine grandchildren.

ROBERT COFFEY, FDPS, FWEIP, HENDERSONVILLE, NC Bob first incorporated his photographic skills in the corporate world, then as a business owner and finally as an instructor. After graduating in Chemical Engineering from Texas A&M University, Bob's professional photography work began in support of his marketing career. His prints and images have won awards in local, national and international competitions and they have been published in various newspapers, magazines, books and annual reports. Since 1980, Bob has held many camera club positions including president of the Louisiana Photographic Society and program director, education director, WIEP chairman and president of Delaware Photographic Society where he was named a Lifetime Member in 2014. He is currently the program director for the Camera Club of Hendersonville where he continues his passion for helping others learn more about photography.

MAJDI AL NASER, AFIAP, SAIHAT, SAUDI ARABIA A Business Development Manager by profession, Majdi is also the Founder and President of the Gulf Photographers Center. Their mission is to create a new generation of professional photographers based on a plan of education with many courses and workshops by local and internationally known photographers. In 2016 they conducted their first international photographic exhibition. Majdi also serves as Photography Department Supervisor of the Saudi Arabian Society for Culture and Arts. He developed an interest in photography when he was 11 years old. Three years later, his father, seeing his passion, replaced his point-and-shoot with a professional Minolta SLR. His favorite subjects are portraits and street photography and last year he completed the Professional Photography Course from The New York Institute of Photography. An active member of the Photographic Society of America (PSA), he has attended several annual PSA conferences in the U.S.

#### **PICTORIAL PRINTS**

DAVID STOUT, PPSA, EFIAP, TYNESIDE, ENGLAND David was raised in the city of Newcastle upon Tyne. He worked for 44 years as a printer of banknotes and still does occasional freelancing in that field. Since his first overseas trip to Venice, Athens, Istanbul and Naples in 1964, he has set out to travel and photograph as much of the world as possible. He gained Licentiateship of the Royal Photographic Society in 1987 and attained the level of Associateship in 1990. As a result of his extensive portfolio, he has over 900 acceptances, earning EFIAP and PPSA distinctions. He is currently a member of two PSA study groups for

projected images and is a member of a camera club in North East England. David started photographing with a Kodak Brownie 44a and after many equipment changes has moved to a Canon EOS 5D Mark 3 with various lenses. Examples of his work can be viewed at www.davidjstout.net.

LOUIS DUNCAN, APSA, PPSA, JAMESTOWN, NC Louis is an Aerospace Engineer whose vocation included wind tunnel and track testing. He also served as the aero test engineer for the gold medal U. S. Olympic Bobsled team for six Winter Olympics. Louis' avocation is photography. Within the last ten years he has received over 1400 acceptances in international exhibitions and has stars in projected color and monochrome, nature, photojournalism, photo travel and color and monochrome prints. Louis is active in promoting the Photographic Society of America (PSA) and has served as the Print Division Chair, Society Recognition Awards Committee Chair, PSA Print Collection Committee Chair, Pictorial Print of the Year Competition Director, International Club Print Competition Director, PSA Portfolio Distinctions Assessor and member of the PSA President's Ad-Hoc Enrichment Committee. He also serves as the PSA representative for the Carolinas' Nature Photographers Association, a PSA member club. Louis received the PSA Early Achievement Award in 2012. Louis says, "My photo life is mostly digital, but I still have an active wet darkroom. I am not unhappy with monochrome digital printing, but I still prefer the feel, contrast and the texture of a well-made darkroom fiber print."

WALLY LEE, FPSA, PPSA, EDMOND, OK Wally joined the Oklahoma Camera Club in 1978, gradually started to enter slides and prints into club competition and found the feedback to be very beneficial. As he got more active in the club, he held most of the various positions. Wally has been President, Treasurer, Secretary and Board Director. He also served as Hypocheck editor and Yearbook editor for several years. Wally chaired several divisions of the Oklahoma International Exhibition and was Co-chairman of the exhibition three times. He joined PSA in 1987 and has served as the co-chairman for the Projected Image Division (PID) Star Ratings Program. His main interests in photography are nature and landscapes and he competes in both projected and print categories. He shoots a Sony A77 Mark II with the Tamron 16-300mm as his main lens. In 2009, Wally, together with his wife Jan, hosted the Beginning Image workshop and has continued to do that ever since.

#### **PHOTOJOURNALISM**

JOHN ANDREW HUGHES, APSA, LAS VEGAS, NV John studied photography in high school and completed a four year apprenticeship with a press photographer. His first published image appeared in a local newspaper at age sixteen and he worked on London's 'Fleet Street' in the 1980s during the heyday of newspapers. He was published in nearly every major newspaper in the U.K. Moving to the U.S. in 1994, he has done contract work for New York Daily News, Philadelphia Daily News, CVS Pharmacy and The American Society of Clinical Oncology. John joined the Photographic Society of America (PSA)

in 2009, becoming Jon Fishback's first instructor for PSA Education Services. He has served PSA as Membership Star Program Director, West Coast Area Membership Director, Projected Image Division Second Vice Chair and Photojournalism Division Photo Story Competition Director. John has been awarded a PSA Editorial Silver Star, a Membership Star and the PSA Early Achievement Award. John has judged for the Nevada Camera Club, S4C and the PSA Photojournalism Division. JAN LEE, FPSA, EPSA, EDMOND, OK Jan started her photographic life early, as both parents were avid artists and photographers by avocation. One of her first recollections is of her first camera. She was fortunate to be in art classes for many media and uses that knowledge in her photography. After graduating from college, she became more active in photography. She joined the Oklahoma Camera Club, a PSA member club, and has served as club president three times. Jan has chaired the Oklahoma International Exhibition several times and has also judged in each section. She joined PSA in 1987 and chaired all four print classes of the PSA International for six years. She served as the Star Ratings Co-Director for four projected image categories as the divisions transitioned over nine years. She also served as the PSA Treasurer for three years. For Jan, monochrome photography comes first, but she loves all genres. Jan is a frequent exhibitor, with ratings from three stars to two galaxies in every PSA division or class except 3DD and is close to her fifth star in photojournalism. Jan enjoys spending time with her husband, Wally, also a photographer.

NICK UT, LOS ANGELES, CA Born in Vietnam, Nick joined the Associated Press at age 16 following the death of his older brother, an AP photographer. Covering that war for eight years, he took many successful photographs, including the "napalm girl," nine-year-old Phan Thi Kim Phuc, running naked and screaming after her clothes were burned off. Realizing the extent of her injuries, he took her for medical help before returning to AP to develop his film. The iconic image was widely published, named World Press Photo of 1972, awarded the 1973 Pulitzer Prize and credited with helping to turn public sentiment against the war. He spent another decade working in Tokyo, Hanoi, Laos and Cambodia before reassignment to Los Angeles. There he photographed the Olympics, wildfires, earthquakes, riots and celebrities. He has stayed in touch with Kim, now living in Canada. Last year he retired from AP after 51 years and was honored with PSA's International Understanding Through Photography award, given annually for photography that has impacted people's perceptions. His prize-winning work over the years has resulted in his presentation, "From Hell to Hollywood." He is married and has two grown children.

#### **AWARDS**



Photographic Society of America provides the following medals: from the Projected Image Division (PID), a Gold Medal for Best Projected Image, a Silver, and a Bronze; from the Pictorial Print Division (PPD), Gold Medals for Best Monochrome Print, Best Color Print and Best Small Print, Silvers, and Bronze in each of these print classes; and from the Photojournalism

Division (PJD), Gold Medals for "Best Photojournalism Projected Image" and "Best Photojournalism Print," Silvers for "Best Human Interest" and Bronze for "Best Storytelling" in each section.



**Mid-Atlantic Chapter of PSA** donates six medals, one for the next best image in each section.



**Delaware Photographic Society**, founded in 1931 as The Delaware Camera Club, presents Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals, plus Honor Ribbons, in each division for photographic excellence.



South Jersey Camera Club (SJCC) donates a Gold Medal to an outstanding nature image in *Projected Images* and in *Large Color Prints*.



Delaware Valley Council of Camera Clubs donates four DVCCC medals, one in each print section for an outstanding image by a member of a camera club in the Council. The DVCCC includes clubs in the tri-state area of Delaware, Southeastern Pennsylvania, and New Jersey.

#### **ERIK KISSA MEMORIAL AWARD**

The Erik Kissa Memorial Award for the Best in PSA was established in 2018 in memory of Dr. Erik Kissa, FPSA, MPSA, FWIEP, who was a long-serving member of both the Photographic Society of America and the Delaware Photographic Society and who championed the benefits of PSA membership. The medal will be awarded each year at the Wilmington International Exhibition of Photography to recognize the PSA member, worldwide, with the most acceptances in the exhibition.
