





Join PSA member Ranjan Ramchandani on a virtual safari in the Masai Mara, Kenya. Ranjan, who has been conducting photography workshops and taking guests on safaris for almost two decades, will tell us how to plan for a safari trip, what to pack and take us into the wilderness on this virtual journey from start to finish, with slides and images. The Masai Mara, situated in south-west Kenya is one of Africa's greatest Wildlife Reserves. It is a photographer's and naturalist's paradise, with abundant elephants, buffalos, giraffes, lions and cheetahs alongside the migratory wildebeest. Ranjan will conclude his presentation with some unique images from around the world.

Ranjan Ramchandani is an Olympus Visionary. He is a Singapore based, published photographer focusing on travel and wildlife. A graduate of the New York Institute of Photography, he has honed his skills through photography expeditions around the globe with an emphasis on major wildlife destinations. Ranjan's work has appeared in various media in India and the US, including *Sanctuary Asia, Outdoor Photographer* and most recently *The Wild Lens*. He has received international recognition and awards in competitions and his works have appeared in private galleries in many countries. Ranjan is Asia/Africa Editor for *The Wild Lens*, recently launched in the US. His book – "Masai Mara, A Wild Escape" is due for release in late April, 2021.
