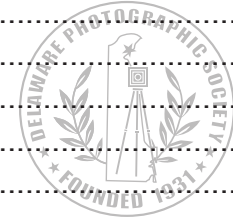

PHILLIP KWAN**

AGATHA ANNE BUNANTA, APSA, GMPSA, JAKARTA, INDONESIA A native of Indonesia, Agatha served as their International Representative after joining PSA in 2005, and in 2010 she was appointed as the PSA Membership Director and Liaison Officer for Indonesia. She is founder and director of "Art Photography of Indonesia," a nonprofit organization that connects and encourages collaboration and networking with photographic organizations and individuals nationally and internationally to promote the development of photography in Indonesia. She is an award-winning photographer with more than 3000 international exhibition

acceptances, more than 400 medals and HM's in national and international competitions, and has been involved in joint photo exhibitions in the USA, Oman, Thailand, Turkey, Austria, Belgium, Vietnam, Morocco, and Indonesia, among others. She has been listed Tops in Who's Who many times since 2006 for digital success in Photo Travel, Photojournalism, Electronic Imaging and Projected Image, as well as for small prints in Monochrome, Color, Photo Travel and Nature. She has judged many national and international photo competitions, and actively introduces, teaches, helps and encourages Indonesian photographers to participate internationally.

PHILLIP KWAN, GPSA, GMPSA/P, TORONTO CANADA Although his interest in photography started in high school, Phillip's next 30 years were busy with family and business responsibilities. In 2002, he joined PSA and started entering International salons. His success has been recognized by the Royal Photographic Society with FRPS, by FIAP with EFIAP, and by PSA with Platinum Grand Master. In addition to his outstanding achievement in photographic competition, Phillip has been honored with PSA's prestigious Gold award for his portfolio (GPSA), has qualified for their Master Photojournalist award (MPJ), and has accepted invitations to judge several International exhibitions. He is an advisor to CCPST (The Chinese Canadian Photographic Society of Toronto), and has recently accepted an appointment as one of PSA's new Assistant ROPA Directors in charge of reviewing all applications for all levels of the GMPSA distinction. His particular photographic interests are Nature and Travel, and he especially enjoys travelling to different parts of the world for wildlife photography.

DEE LANGEVIN, MPSA, TOWNSEND, DE Dee is a retired analytical chemist who worked in the pharmaceutical industry. Her passion in retirement has become nature and wildlife photography. Dee has been a PSA member since 2009 and has achieved the MPSA Distinction, with multiple Galaxy awards in PID Color and Nature and multiple Star Awards in PID Monochrome, Photojournalism and Photo Travel. She has been listed in the PSA Who's Who Top Exhibitors in North America in CPID, PID Color, PID Mono, Nature, Photo Travel and Photojournalism and has her images included in the PSA Permanent Collection. Dee has been Chair of the Wilmington International Exhibition of Photography and has served the Delaware Photographic Society as a Mentor, Recording Secretary and Chair of the Standards Committee. Her photographs have been exhibited in museums and venues in the mid-Atlantic region and she has presented numerous talks on photography, including "Wildlife in Our National Parks" at the 2017 PSA Annual Conference.

KEN MURPHY, RANDY CARR, BOB GINN

RANDY CARR, APSA, MPSA2, YUKON, OK Randy learned photography from his dad who enjoyed travelling the US, especially Colorado. While in the service, Randy was inspired by the USO's darkroom and two friends who had minored in photography. In 2004 he joined PSA, entered the Oklahoma Salon, and discovered the joy of photographic competition. He has accumulated Stars and Galaxies in five divisions, has twice won PSA's PJ of the Year, and recently qualified for their Master Photojournalist designation. He is also an award-winning monochrome printer. With over 2400 international acceptances, he is striving for PSA's GMPSA distinction. He has two Silver Medals for

contributions to the PSA Journal, and his work has appeared twice on the cover. He has served as Exhibition Standards Director, Chairman of the Photojournalism Division and Vice President of Exhibition Services. But his Oklahoma City club continues to be an influence. Monthly competition keeps him sharp, inspires him to help others, and stimulates him to try new subjects, such as portraits and landscapes. But capturing a boxer's point of impact or the peak of a motorcyclist stunt is his passion.

BOB GINN APSA, GUADALUPE, CA A 45-year member of PSA, Bob has served as Executive Vice President, and continues to run the Georgia Circuits, which he established 29 years ago. He has judged over 50 photographic competitions and exhibitions, and has been invited to speak at three NPPA events, twice at the Public Relations Society of America, and at over 15 PSA gatherings, including numerous International conferences. After earning his degree at University of California Berkeley, he worked at major newspapers both as a shooter and editor, covering eight Olympic games, 20 wars and over 300 Formula 1 races, and then worked freelance for 30 years doing over 2,400 assignments worldwide. He has been Photographer of the Year four times in two states and five times in three regions. In PSA he was ranked Tops in Who's Who worldwide 18 times. His average acceptance record was 3.2 out of four, and his five stars in PJ prints and three in pictorial prints were earned without using any image more than once.

KEN MURPHY, APSA, EPSA, GREAT FALLS, MT A Viet Nam veteran, Ken retired from the US Air Force before pursuing his love of photography. Frequently published in horse racing magazines, he held licenses in six states as a photo finish and winners circle photographer. Joining PSA in 1996, he didn't participate in exhibitions until 2002, when he entered Wilmington International Exhibition of Photography and was awarded a Delaware Camera Club Gold Medal. Ken has five stars in PJ and PPD color, four stars in Travel, two Galaxies in PID and Nature, and stars in PID and PPD monochrome. He has served as Regional Director for Montana, Wyoming and part of South Dakota and then as Montana Membership Director. Currently he is the chairman of the Pictorial Print Division Chairman. Much of Ken's Nature photography has included hummingbirds. He has traveled north to British Columbia and south to Arizona, Costa Rica, and Ecuador to capture a variety of species. Recently he has gotten involved in astrophotography, taking advantage of Montana's dark and clear skies, along with frequent displays of the Northern Lights.

PHOTOJOURNALISM



RON SOLIMAN, NYLA JAMES, HAL BUELL

HAL BUELL, NEW YORK NY Hal spent more than 40 years with Associated Press, 25 of them as head of AP's worldwide photo service and its 300 photo editors and photographers. He has worked on assignment in more than 35 countries, organizing and managing AP's news picture coverage. During his tenure, AP staff won 12 Pulitzers and numerous other prestigious awards. He also headed up a program to bring digital photography and picture transmission to the AP, revolutionizing picture handling at the wire service and within newspapers, and including development of a digital picture

archive that now contains more than seven million pictures. He authored 15 books about photography, has appeared as a photo commentator on NBC, ABC, CBS, PBS, CBC, NPR and has consulted on documentaries for History Channel. He has lectured internationally on photo ethics and has judged many competitions, including the Pulitzer Prize and World Press Photo. He was honored with NPPA's Sprague Award, their highest recognition, and was named Photo Editor of the Year. He holds Bachelor's and Master's degrees from Medill School of Journalism, Northwestern University.

NYLA JAMES, ARROYO GRANDE, CA Nyla's photography has been featured on the web site of KCET, the PBS channel in Los Angeles. She has had two single-person shows in museums there, and her ten-year project on flags of the USA has resulted in a book, with others in the works. She has served as Conference Program Chair of PSA's Photojournalism Division and is currently their First Vice Chair. She has chaired sections of the PSA International Exhibition several times for the Photo Travel and Photojournalism Divisions, and has managed both the projected and print sections of the Ollie Fife Biennial Theme Exhibition sponsored by the Photojournalism Division. She has also presented for the division at two PSA International conferences. As PSA's State Membership Director for California, she has visited clubs throughout the state, has presented programs at more than 20 PSA club gatherings and, respected and sought after for her astute judging, she has juried more than 15 photographic competitions.

RON SOLIMAN, PHOTOJOURNALIST, BEAR, DE Ron is a former Director of Photography at The Wilmington News Journal with over 18 years of newspaper experience, and has earned awards from the National Press Photographers Association and other organizations. Born in Angeles City, Philippines, the youngest of nine children, he was given a 110 mm film camera and captured pictures of the first woman president of the Philippines during a school event. These first photojournalistic images started his dream to be a documentary photographer. Upon his family's immigration to the US, he attended California State University - Fullerton, earning a degree in Communications focusing on Photojournalism. After graduation, he was hired by the Los Angeles Times and then Gannett, and has been published in American Photo, Sports Illustrated and USA Today, among others. Then he began traveling the world to photograph weddings from Africa to Paris to Rome. He is ranked in the Top 15 Wedding Photojournalists in the World and has received awards of excellence from Wedding and Portrait Photographers International Association. Photographic Society of America provides the following medals: from the Projected Image Division (PID), a Gold Medal for *Best Projected Image*, a Silver, and a Bronze; from the Pictorial Print Division (PPD), Gold Medals for *Best Monochrome Print*, *Best Color Print* and *Best Small Print*, Silvers, and Bronze in each of these print classes; and from the Photojournalism Division (PJD), Gold Medals for "*Best Photojournalism Projected Image*" and "*Best Photojournalism Print*," Silvers for "*Best Human Interest*" and Bronze for "*Best Storytelling*" in each section.



PSA Mid-Atlantic Chapter Gold donates six medals, one for the next best image in each section.



Delaware Photographic Society, founded in 1931 as The Delaware Camera Club, presents Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals, plus Honor Ribbons, in each division for photographic excellence.



South Jersey Camera Club (SJCC) donates a Gold Medal to an outstanding nature image in *Projected Images* and in *Large Color Prints*.



Delaware Valley Council of Camera Clubs donates four DVCCC medals, one in each print section for an outstanding image by a member of a camera club in the Council. The DVCCC includes clubs in the tri-state area of Delaware, Southeastern Pennsylvania, and New Jersey.

ERIK KISSA MEMORIAL AWARD

The **Erik Kissa Memorial Award** for the **Best in PSA** was established in 2018 in memory of Dr. Erik Kissa, FPSA, MPSA, FWIEP, who was a long-serving member of both the **Photographic Society of America** and the **Delaware Photographic Society** and who championed the benefits of PSA membership. The medal will be awarded each year at the **Wilmington International Exhibition of Photography** to recognize the PSA member, worldwide, with the most acceptances in the exhibition.
