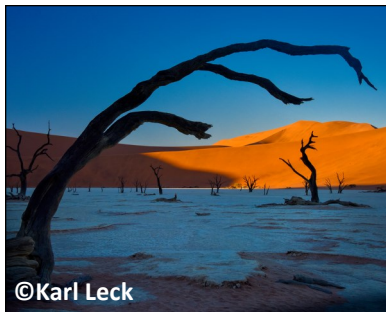
**“What Makes an Image Stand Out”

We all would like our photographs to be noticed in competitions, publications, exhibitions or just as prints decorating our homes. In this webinar we celebrate images that stand out by examining some of the characteristics that catch a viewer's attention. Characteristics include a recognizable subject, unusual point-of-view, dramatic color or tonality, peak action moment and others. Not all images will fare well in both competition and exhibition. The photographer should be aware of the venue in which the image can be most successful based on its characteristics. Karl will illustrate these characteristics with some of his well-known images along with ones plucked from 55 years of photo files. For many images the backstory can be enlightening and entertaining.



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Karl Leck has been photographing for more than fifty years, half of which were spent photographing international equestrian sports, including six summer Olympic Games and world championships in North America and Europe. A world-traveler, Karl has photographed on every continent. His photographs have appeared on more than fifty magazine covers and in numerous equestrian sport and photography books. Credits include *Sports Illustrated*, *National Geographic*, *USA Today*, *US News & World Report*, *Olympian*, *L'Ainee Hippique*, *M*, *EQUUS*, *Chronicle of the Horse*, *Practical Horseman*, *Pittsburgh Press*, and *Carnegie Technical*. Karl has

twice won PSA's Smith Award for Photojournalist of the Year. He is a Fellow of the Delaware Photographic Society and the sole Master Fellow of the Wilmington International Exhibition of Photography. Karl currently serves as Print Director for both organizations. He speaks and judges at meetings of many Delaware Valley organizations. Since retiring from editorial photography, Karl continues to expand his photographic knowledge and experience. He participates in several regional solo and group fine art print exhibits each year, believing that the lasting form of great photographs is in the print.
